- (a) Each authority shall have all of the powers **necessary** or **convenien**t to carry out and effectuate the **purposes** and **prevision** of this chapter, including without limiting the generality of the forgoing, the power: ...

NEW GRANT FUNDING

USDA Launches Grant Program to Help Expand Regional Economies and Create High-Wage Jobs in Distressed Rural Communities

WASHINGTON, June 15, 2021 – United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Development Rural Business-Cooperative Service Administrator Karama Neal today unveiled a new grant program to help rural communities create goodpaying jobs and support new business opportunities in high-growth fields.

THE RISE GRANT PROFILE

The Rural Innovation Stronger Economy (RISE) grant is intended to help rural communities identify and maximize local assets and connect to networks and industry clusters within their *region*. This new grant encourages a *regional*, innovation-driven approach to economic development. The RISE program ensures that critical funding supports long-term and sustainable economic growth in the rural communities and regions that need it most.

RISE provides grants of up to \$2 million to consortiums of local governments, investors, industry, institutions of higher education, and other public and private entities in rural areas. The funds may be used to form job accelerator partnerships and create high-wage jobs, start or expand businesses, and support economic growth in the rural areas of their region.

WORKFORCE TRAINING

Funding may also be used to establish and operate innovation centers and partnerships, such as integrating rural businesses into new supply chains, *PROVIDING WORKFORCE*TRAINING and identifying community assets

To help ensure long-term and sustainable community and economic development, award recipients must support projects for at least four years

RISE GRANT DEADLINES

Starting *June 16, 2021*, applications will be accepted electronically at Grants.gov. Applications must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time on *Aug. 2, 2021*

RISE GRANT LIFE

\$500 k to 2 mill a year, Multi-year, 10 mill @ 80% (matching 20% can't be other Fed/Gov money)

- 1. Region and clusters within their *region*.
- 2. Identifying community assets.
- 3. Workforce Training
- 4. Construction Trades PRACTICE School.
- 5. High-paying jobs
- 6. Under 50 k inhabitants *HAVE PRIORITY*.

1. REGION & REGIONAL



Two Regions were clearly identified:

1. The entire County

2. The DDA's region formed by ACTIVATED DDA's in **Abbeville**, **Pitts**, and *Pineview*?

2. COMMUNITY ASSETS

- 1. Wilcox County Schools
- 2. The Faith-based Community = Church(es)
- 3. The **POOR** and unemployed people of Rochelle/Wilcox County
- 4. Local/regional entrepreneurship/ Small businesses
- 5. Farm and Agricultural entities/business

3. WORKFORCE TRAINING

- RISE Funding may also be used to establish and operate innovation centers and partnerships, such as integrating rural businesses into new supply chains, providing workforce training and identifying community assets.
- To help ensure long-term and sustainable community and economic development, award recipients must support projects for at least four years

COMMUNITY NEED

- Need to keep up with social and technological changes to survive.
- Our community urgently need to empower our young generations to succeed; including and specially **FEMALES**.
- JOBS, JOBS, and HIGH WAGE-Paying JOBS.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

- Such program should help develop the labor force that now, we do not have.
- It will be Wilcox County inclusive to help other DDA cities in the county with certified labor requirements.
- Provides the opportunity for employment in the construction trades with state licensing as required.
- Provide the opportunity to acquire the required PRACTICE hours (400) in the construction trades while building or renovating houses.



EXPERIENCE CERTIFICATION

- Applicant should be able to document three or more years of Experience prior to take the exam.
- The State of Georgia relies on honest and accurate institutions for proof and certification of PRACTICE hours to extend licenses. Practice hours are computed at 400 total.

Community HOME Investment Program (CHIP)

The purpose of the **Community HOME Investment Program** (CHIP) is to provide safe, decent, and affordable housing in Georgia by granting funds to city and county governments, public housing authorities, and nonprofits to 1.)rehabilitate owneroccupied homes and 2.) build and renovate affordable single family homes for sale to eligible homebuyers.

THE CHIP PROGRAM FUNDING

(EVERY TWO YEARS)


- HOUSING REHABILITATION of owner-occupied homes: grants up to \$400,000
- NEW construction and/or rehabilitation (flipping) of homes for SALE to eligible homebuyers: grants up to 600,000.
- Mortgage funding by: FHA, the GEORGIA
 DREAM PROGRAM and other.
- FIRST TIME Home-buyers assistance
- DOWN-PAYMENT assistance

CONSTRUCTION TRADES PRACTICE SCHOOL PRODUCTS:

- Certify Construction Trades Practice hours (400) to apply for State license.
- **Home rehabilitation** of area dilapidated homes (eligible homeowner occupant).
- Homes for sale, rehab & new construction (to eligible home buyers)
- A way to **RE-URBANIZED** District One.
- Can shepherd own members to be homeowners.
- Stable, affluent and strong communities produce stable, affluent and strong churches


Prochelle Ga Educational Attainment by Sex (over 25)

Sex








