## **Trash and Recycling Information**

- Trash must be bagged before placing it in the cart. Recycling must be rinsed and unbagged (loose) in its cart.
- Bins and curbside collection services are provided by a private contractor, NOT the City of Madison.
- Bins must be labeled with your street number and be **stored in the garage at all times** except for collection days.
- Place bins at the curb on the sidewalk before 7:00am each Thursday. (If Monday thru Thursday is a holiday, pickup will be the next non-holiday business day.) Recycling is collected every other week. Place bins at the curb no more than 12 hours before the day of collection and **return bins to your garage within 24 hours** after collection day.
- Place bins at least 3 feet apart with the lid opening toward the street. Lids must be closed to ensure pickup. If a lid does not close, you may place some of your items in other bins, hold items for the following week, or take items to the city drop-off sites identified under Disposal of Items Not Collected at Curbside below.
- Place holiday trees at the curb on Tancho Drive for pickup by the City of Madison.

- no lids unless marked code 1-7\*

  - Styrofoam blocks with code 1-7
  - no Styrofoam peanuts\*

- paperboard (cereal boxes)
- no paper towels, napkins, tissue, plates or waxed paper materials\*

- no aluminum foil\*
- no pots, pans or utensils\*
- no motor oil bottles\*

## Disposal of Items Not Collected at Curbside

Our private contractor does not pick up any of the items listed below, however
