Deed Restrictions

To keep our neighborhood looking good, we will be contacting residents in the community about on a driveway about 30 days and/or until the removing broken down vehicles from driveways, some of which have been parked there for several vears.

According to the City of Houston, covering your vehicle with a tarp is not a permanent solution for broken down vehicles on the driveways. temporary fix only!

Wrecked vehicles, that are undriveable, can stay insurance company works with you, or they can be stored under a tarp for about 2 months. Afterwards, you will be alerted that you must store it in your garage or proceed with whatever plans you have.

Rules and Regulations of Gulf Meadows

- 1. Do not park vehicles, trailers, or boats on front and side yards of home, on grass.
- 2. Keep wrecked vehicles stored in enclosed areas at your property.
- 3. Do not store inoperable vehicles on the street.
- 4. Do not leave cars on flat, on streets and driveways for a long time.
- 5. Keep ALL boats covered (to alleviate standing water and mosquitos).
- 6. Do not bring or park eighteen- wheel cabs in Gulf Meadows (Hard on streets).
- 7. Mow and edge yards regularly.
- 8. Do not store clutter on front and side yards of your home.
- 9. Obey heavy trash schedule. Do not put trash out too early.
- 10. Control rodents around your property.
- 11. Install address on property.
- 12. Repair or replace broken fence(s) on your property.
- 13. Keep dogs on leashes when you leave your property.
- 14. Do not install basketball goals on the street(s). It is very dangerous!
- 15. Do not store garbage can(s) in the front of home.


