

BPD Redistricting Plan -- Phase 2



In May, 2022, Mayor Brandon Scott and Commissioner Michael Harrison announced their plan to bring the department into 21st century policing by redrawing the geographic boundaries of its nine police districts. This will mark the biggest change to district lines in more than 60 years.

The Redistricting Plan intends to keep neighborhoods together, manage the crime more effectively in each geographic area, create better alignment for the Crime Reduction Strategy, provide officer workload balance, and optimize resource allocation for smarter policing.

Now that the lines have been redrawn, later this week the BPD will be opening up a second public input process for community feedback on the proposed geographic boundaries.
