## Long Beach Expands Monkeypox Vaccine Eligibility to Additional Groups

The Long Beach Health Department is expanding the eligibility criteria for the monkeypox (MPX) vaccine, effective immediately. This decision is in alignment with Los Angeles County and done in order to make the vaccine more readily accessible to those at high risk and to stop the spread of MPX.

The MPX vaccine is now available to:

- People who were exposed to someone with confirmed MPX and do not have symptoms.
- People who attended an event/venue where there was high risk of exposure to someone with confirmed MPX.
- Residents who are immunocompromised, including those with advanced or uncontrolled HIV, who may be at high risk for severe disease.
- Gay or bisexual men and transgender people:
  - Who are on HIV pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP).
  - Who attended saunas, bathhouses, sex clubs, circuit parties or sex parties where they had anonymous sex or sex with multiple partners.
  - With a diagnosis of gonorrhea or early syphilis within the past 12 months.
  - Who had multiple or anonymous sex partners in the last 14 days.
- **New:** Gay or bisexual men and transgender people who had skin-to-skin or intimate contact (e.g., kissing, hugging) with persons at large venues or events in the past 14 days.
- **New:** Persons of any gender or sexual orientation who engaged in commercial and/or transactional sex in the past 14 days (e.g., sex in exchange for money, shelter, food and other goods or needs).

In addition, a limited number of appointments are available this week on [MyTurn](#) for City-run MPX vaccine clinics. Last week, the City [transitioned](#) its pre-registration system over to MyTurn but prioritized appointments for those who already registered with the City. Starting Aug. 30, City-run MPX vaccine clinics will be open to all who register on [MyTurn](#).

### Gun Buy Back Operation Saturday, September 10th

There will be a Gun Buy Back Operation in partnership with Long Beach Police and Los Angeles County Supervisor Janice Hahn scheduled to take place at Ramona Park, on Saturday, September 10th from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Although shootings have been reduced by 12.8% year to date, nearly 30% of the citywide shootings have occurred in North Division. Ramona Park, located at 3351 E. 65th Street, is an easily accessible and available location that will allow the community to safely dispose of unwanted firearms.

### Public Notice: Oversized Vehicle Restrictions

Commencing July 1, 2018, the following oversized vehicle restrictions will go into effect:

- Parking of oversized vehicles (exceeding 85 inches high, or 80 inches wide, or 22 feet long) is prohibited on city streets in residential neighborhoods without a valid permit.
- Residents may obtain free oversized vehicle parking permits for themselves and their visitors at <http://www.longbeach.gov/parking/oversized-permit/>.
- Residents and their visitors may park oversized vehicles adjacent to their residence for a maximum of 72 consecutive hours with a valid permit.
- An annual maximum of 12 permits may be issued to each resident per calendar year.
- Exceptions to these restrictions may be requested in writing from the City Traffic Engineer.
