The Baltimore City Mayor's Office of Employment Development (MOED) and Department of Public Works (DPW) has partnered with the Chesapeake Water Environment Association (CWEA) to design and operate the $\mathbf{YH_2O}$ Career Mentoring Program (" $\mathbf{YH_2O}$ ") for Baltimore City residents, ages 18-24, who have a high school diploma or GED, are unemployed or underemployed and, are not currently enrolled in a job training program or post-secondary education. Baltimore City is proud of the 131 young men and women who have successfully completed $\mathbf{YH_2O}$ since its inception in 2015.

WHAT IS YH2O?

 YH_2O is a program which prepares young adults to be employed in full-time jobs within the water industry at the completion of the program. The goals of YH_2O are to:

- Educate Baltimore City young adults about the water industry and its career opportunities
- Develop a pipeline of future workers with the right skills to fill entry-level positions in the water industry
