#### **Deed Restrictions**

Broken Fences – On our last drive through of Gulf Meadows, we noticed several fences leaning, some with broken gates, missing boards, and a couple of fences built with a mixture of rusty metal and old, rotten wood.

Having a fence around your backyard is not required by Gulf Meadows. It is your choice to have a fence. However, if you have a fence, you must keep it repaired with decent materials (not to repair with any kind of materials).

Keeping your fences repaired is another way that residents in Gulf Meadows work to preserve our community.

NOTE: Working with your neighbors, when replacing a fence, is advised.

#### **Rules and Regulations of Gulf Meadows**

- 1. Do not park vehicles, trailers, or boats on front and side yards of home, on grass.
- 2. Keep wrecked vehicles stored in enclosed areas at your property.
- 3. Do not store inoperable vehicles on the street.
- 4. Do not leave cars on flat, on streets and driveways for a long time.
- 5. Keep ALL boats covered (to alleviate standing water and mosquitos).
- 6. Do not bring or park eighteen- wheel cabs in Gulf Meadows (Hard on streets).
- 7. Mow and edge yards regularly.
- 8. Do not store clutter on front and side yards of your home.
- 9. Obey heavy trash schedule. Do not put trash out too early.
- 10. Control rodents around your property.
- 11. Install address on property.
- 12. Repair or replace broken fence(s) on your property.
- 13. Keep dogs on leashes when you leave your property.
- 14. Do not install basketball goals on the street(s). It is very dangerous!
- 15. Do not store garbage can(s) in the front of home.

- 13. Mantenga a los perros con sanguijvelas cuando slogan de su propiedad.
- 14. No pongas porterias de baloncesto en la calle Muy peligroso!
- 15. No almacene botes de basura en frente de la casa.
