9th District City Councilman Leads The way Again!

Long Beach City Council voted to purchase the Luxury Inn, and convert it into a Project Homekey site using newly-available state funding.

<u>Project Homekey</u> is an initiative by the State that allows local governments to purchase hotels and other such buildings and convert them to short-term housing for homelessness relief.

By acquiring the Luxury Inn, we are removing the biggest nuisance motel in the city and disrupting a haven for human trafficking. This strategy, along with the new zoning updates on hand in UPLAN, will ensure the future safety of the Corridor—a motel will not be allowed there again. In the coming months, the City of Long Beach will secure an operator and conduct outreach in the community while making a commitment to maintaining security and quality of life.

Public Notice: Oversized Vehicle Restrictions

Commencing July 1, 2018, the following oversized vehicle restrictions will go into effect:

- Parking of oversized vehicles (exceeding 85 inches high, or 80 inches wide, or 22 feet long) is prohibited on city streets in residential neighborhoods without a valid permit.
- Residents may obtain free oversized vehicle parking permits for themselves and their visitors at http://www.longbeach.gov/parking/oversized-permit/.
- Residents and their visitors may park oversized vehicles adjacent to their residence for a maximum of 72 consecutive hours with a valid permit.
- An annual maximum of 12 permits may be issued to each resident per calendar year.
- Exceptions to these restrictions may be requested in writing from the City Traffic Engineer.





Need for Signs, Monitoring Lights and increased Policing

No Loitering, Prostitution, Solicitation, Pandering, ETC. There is a dire need for a "School Youth and Community Safety and Safe Passage Corridor" on major streets with direct access to our elementary school.

Areas selected were based on the increased number openly visible scantily clad females standing and walking in the areas at certain times of the day. We believe that the pimps may also be close by. We do not want your children to feel unsafe, be targeted, recruited, kidnapped, or influenced by this activity. These observations of activity are part of a cross community collaboration between the four neighborhoods in North Long Beach that border these streets.
