Wes Memeger: The Square and Other Concerns

Our neighbor on Coverly Road will have some of his art on exhibition at the Delaware Art Museum Oct 15, 2022 thru Jan 22, 2023. The exhibition preview is Friday, Oct 21.

As described on the Delaware Art Museum web site, Wes “uses the square as a building block, developing abstract compositions that layer form, color, and texture. The artist adds circles and arcs, gold leaf, or fluorescent colors creating works that capture for him, “significant dynamism, but at the same time, surprising tranquility.” The paintings in this exhibition are as much about the square as they are about our perceptions of supposedly rigid shapes in our world and their slightly, but constantly, shifting nature.”

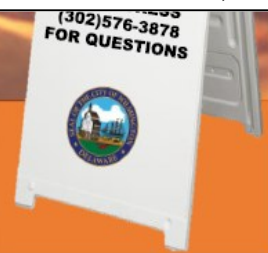

PLEASE NOTE:

- Large piles of leaves should be swept into the street, next to the curb.
- City sweeper or vacuum trucks will collect the leaves from the street.
- When possible, street cleaning will post signage the day before for large volume leaf pick-up.
- Not all city streets can accommodate leaf vacuum services. In those cases, leaves should be placed into brown PAPER BAGS and placed for curbside collection on scheduled recycle days.

PRIVATE CONTRACTORS

If you use a private contractor to remove leaves from your property, please coordinate your leaf removal in accordance with this schedule, or have your contractor bag your leaves in brown PAPER BAGS and place at the curb for pick-up on scheduled recycle days.

COMMUNITY COORDINATE LEAF CLEAN UP PROJECTS

To arrange a community-wide leaf clean-up and schedule collection, please call Wilmington 311. If calling from a landline, please call (302) 576-2620.

HOLIDAYS

If a collection day falls on a holiday, pick-up will occur on the next leaf collection day.

- November 8: Election Day
- November 11: Veteran's Day
- November 24: Thanksgiving Day
- November 25: Day After Thanksgiving

YEAR-ROUND YARDWASTE CURBSIDE COLLECTION REMINDER

All leaves and yard waste should be placed in brown PAPER BAGS and placed next to the curb for pick-up on scheduled recycle days.
