Evergreen Waste Services

Beacon Hill Townhomes is now under a renewed service agreement with Evergreen Waste Services for trash, recycling and yard waste collection. Below are some service questions presented to Evergreen.

- What is considered a bulk item? A bulk item is any household item or 4
 additional 13 gallon kitchen size bags or 2 contract bags.
- Is a text or a phone call to your office required beforehand for the collection of a bulk item? Because we do have special instructions for some household items, we do ask that you schedule any item outside of your Evergreen trash bin. To schedule you can call our office and speak with a customer service representative or you may text us at the exact number (302-635-7055). Examples for special instructions for bulk items: mattress/box springs must be wrapped in any type of plastic or you may use a plastic mattress cover - this is for sanitation purposes for our drivers. Flat screen TV's we ask that you tape the screen from corner to corner so the tape appears as an "X" on the screen - this is for compacting purposes to prevent the screen from shattering onto the driver or onto the pavement. We also provide metal service. This is a weekly and a free service. Examples of what we would consider metal are: Gas/charcoal grill, washer/dryer, cooking range, etc. You must call to have any metal <u>items picked up</u>. One of our Evergreen box truck drivers will come by weekly on Friday to dispose of any metal items.
- Is Christmas tree collection included in the service? With the yard waste services, we provide one Christmas tree per year.

REMEMBER, your containers need to be put at the front of the drive, NOT at the curb or on the lawn area. Soiled items like styrofoam, pizza boxes, plastic food wraps, napkins, paper towels, tissues, etc. are NOT recyclable.
