#### **Deed Restrictions**

#### DOGS RUNNING LOOSE IN GULF MEADOWS.

Many dogs are roaming around freely in our neighborhood. This is not allowed in the city of Houston. The city requires that ALL dog owners MUST keep their dogs on leashes when leaving the confinement of their property. As a pet owner, it is necessary that you take responsibility for your pet and not impose on non-dog owners. REMEMBER: Pet owner(s) are liable for any damage or harm that their animal (s) do.

If any resident knows of any dog (running loose) and you know where they live, we ask that you report to the city and/or to any officer of the board listed on the front page of our newsletter. Your identity will remain private.

#### **Rules and Regulations of Gulf Meadows**

- 1. Do not park vehicles, trailers, or boats on front and side yards of home, on grass.
- 2. Keep wrecked vehicles stored in enclosed areas at your property.
- 3. Do not store inoperable vehicles on the street.
- 4. Do not leave cars on flat, on streets and driveways for a long time.
- 5. Keep ALL boats covered (to alleviate standing water and mosquitos).
- 6. Do not bring or park eighteen- wheel cabs in Gulf Meadows (Hard on streets).
- 7. Mow and edge yards regularly.
- 8. Do not store clutter on front and side yards of your home.
- 9. Obey heavy trash schedule. Do not put trash out too early.
- 10. Control rodents around your property.
- 11. Install address on property.
- 12. Repair or replace broken fence(s) on your property.
- 13. Keep dogs on leashes when you leave your property.
- 14. Do not install basketball goals on the street(s). It is very dangerous!
- 15. Do not store garbage can(s) in the front of home.


