ABANDONED CARS

Lately, several abandoned vehicles have been found in our community. Sometimes they are hard to identify. For the civic club to identify more of those kinds of vehicles, we need your help. Listed below are some of the things that you can do to help eliminate the abandoned vehicles in our community.

- 1. Be very observant of the cars of neighbors living around you.
- 2. Pay attention to whether the vehicle moves or not.
- 3. Note if car tags and/or inspection stickers are on the vehicle or not if you can.
- 4. If you are not sure whether the car is abandoned, notify one of the board members with an address and as much description as possible of vehicle, so that we can work with proper authorities in checking out the vehicle in question.

Rules and Regulations of Gulf Meadows

- 1. Do not park vehicles, trailers, or boats on front and side yards of home, on grass.
- 2. Keep wrecked vehicles stored in enclosed areas at your property.
- 3. Do not store inoperable vehicles on the street.
- 4. Do not leave cars on flat, on streets and driveways for a long time.
- 5. Keep ALL boats covered (to alleviate standing water and mosquitos).
- 6. Do not bring or park eighteen- wheel cabs in Gulf Meadows (Hard on streets).
- 7. Mow and edge yards regularly.
- 8. Do not store clutter on front and side yards of your home.
- 9. Obey heavy trash schedule. Do not put trash out too early.
- 10. Control rodents around your property.
- 11. Install address on property.
- 12. Repair or replace broken fence(s) on your property.
- 13. Keep dogs on leashes when you leave your property.
- 14. Do not install basketball goals on the street(s). It is very dangerous!
- 15. Do not store garbage can(s) in the front of home.
