#### **Garage and Yard Sales**

PLEASE BE ADVISED OF THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS of Yard and Garage Sales:

- There is no City of Houston "garage/yard sale permit."
- 2. The Office of the State Comptroller regulates sales of this type. Residents are allowed to have only TWO such sales within a twelve -month period. Any more than TWO and the resident is recognized as a business and must obtain a sales tax permit from the state.
- Residents should be aware that many subdivisions prohibit solicitation and commercial businesses within residential areas and neighborhoods, and such activity is often restricted.
- 4. Residents seeking to operate a business from their homes must meet other city requirements, including obtaining a Certificate of Occupancy.

The civic club is asking ALL residents to follow rules and regulations of garage and yard sales, for violators will be reported to the Office of the State Comptroller.

#### **Walter Jones Park**

On Wednesday, May 31<sup>st</sup>, I was informed by Mrs. Betty Earl that the water fountain is not working properly. Based on my observation, the water fountain appears to have a leaking pipe at the base. Therefore, the water pressure is low and residents cannot drink from the fountain. This problem was reported to the Houston Parks and Recreation Dept.

On Wednesday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, I observed that the problem with the water fountain had not been addressed. As I continued to walk through the park to take pictures of the walking trail, on the left back side of the park there were homeless citizens living in the park. I asked them to please pick up their trash and I reported the incident.
