






## Harbor Avenue LA County Sanitation Sewer Project

February through June – 2023 Los Angeles County Sanitation

We Have Our Street Back!!!



The equipment has been removed for this project.

The street repairs will include additional asphalt layers. The under level of asphalt to top layer has been completed.

The final layer will take about 6 months to grind and put in the paving cap layer.

The Artesia Intersection is estimated to take about 1 month. The "Odor Scrubber" that helps with smell will remain in place until the project has been closed.

## Prostitution and Human Trafficking

At the beginning of 2023, a controversial California bill repealing <u>loitering related</u> to <u>possible prostitution</u> was signed into law. **SB 357** would severely limit law enforcement's ability to identify victims of human trafficking – even if the victims are minors,"

Leaders from each of the four (4) neighborhoods bordering Long Beach Blvd is working with the Police Department and other City of Long Beach Departments regarding the sex workers and hookers walking our streets, infesting our community, causing physical safety and mental health concerns for our youth and parents taking their children to school.
