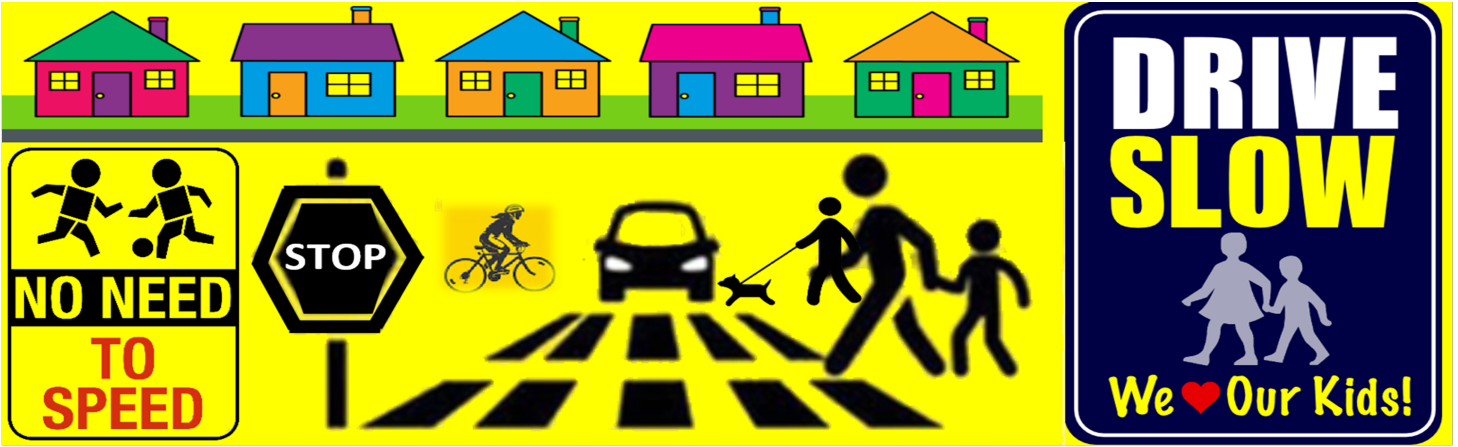

Dear Gateway Towne Center Businesses,

On behalf of the City of Compton, I would like to thank you for your patience, partnership, and perseverance in helping us repair and reopen the Artesia Bridge. This endeavor would not have been possible without the collective support and enthusiasm of our business community, and for that, I am extremely grateful.

As an update on the status of the project, it brings me great pleasure to share with you that the design phase has been completed and we are now one step closer to reopening the Artesia Bridge for our city.

Currently, the bridge is in the pre-construction phase, which involves utility coordination with AT&T TCA, Los Angeles County Sanitation District, SoCal Gas Company, Frontier Communication, and Metropolitan Water District to determine whether their facilities or services will be impacted by the planned construction. Additionally, as of July, the Funding Transfer Agreement is with Caltrans, who will disburse the funding earmarked for the City of Compton to repair the bridge. After we make sure everything is in place, we can begin construction.

Construction for the new bridge is slated to commence on October 16, 2023, and it is anticipated to conclude on April 13, 2024. Please note that this timeline is tentative and subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances that may arise during the construction process. Rest assured, we are committed to keeping you informed and updated on any developments that may impact the project's timeline.

Thank you for your commitment and investment in our community. The reopening of the Artesia Bridge will not only enhance our city's infrastructure but will also foster economic growth, improve accessibility, and create a more connected community. Together, we will continue to build a brighter future for Compton and its residents.

PROJECT LETTER UPDATE

Prostitution and Human Trafficking

At the beginning of 2023, a controversial California bill repealing [loitering related to possible prostitution](#) was signed into law. SB 357 would severely limit law enforcement's ability to identify victims of human trafficking – even if the victims are minors,”

Leaders from each of the four (4) neighborhoods bordering Long Beach Blvd are continuing to work with the Police Department and other City of Long Beach Departments regarding the sex workers and hookers walking our streets, infesting our community, causing physical safety and mental health concerns for our youth and parents taking their children to school.
