Deed Restrictions

We are working to keep ALL Gulf Meadows residents safe. Listed below are some concerns that we feel are SUPER important!!!

- 1) Home address displayed very clearly When one needs an ambulance, it is important to have an address displayed in the front of your home where it is easily seen. This could be the difference between life or death.
- 2) Too many cars parked at a residence Some residents have many vehicles parked on streets. We realize that families have more drivers at home when children grow up, but we feel it is necessary that you use the garage and driveways more frequently, so that emergency vehicles can pass to provide services to the caller that needs assistance. Again, another life or death situation.
- 3) Racing through the neighborhood If you have a young driver in your home, we ask that you talk with them about the importance of driving safely through this community. In the middle of the day or any time, motorists can be heard revving up engines and speeding through the community, which is very dangerous!
- 4) Running stop signs Is a major epidemic in our community. We are asking ALL drivers to be more cognizant of stop signs, high speeds and pedestrians.

As always, we are working to keep Gulf Meadows a safe place for ALL to live and raise their families.
