## Flag Requests

### U.S. Capitol Flag Requests

Congressional and Senator's offices would be glad to request an American flag that has been flown over the United States Capitol building for interested Texans.

In most cases and with at least one week's notice, American flags may be flown for Texans on a specific date. Please note that the United States Senate is only able to fly American flags over the Capitol in Washington, D.C. and does not offer the service of flying a Texas state flag over the United States Capitol – see below for more information on contact information on flying a Texas flag in Austin.

Once a flag order has been received, the normal processing time is six to eight weeks. Processing time may vary around federal holidays. The U.S. Senate, members, and staff are not responsible for flags lost or damaged in the mail.

### CARE OF THE FLAG

Most outdoor flags can be washed in mild detergent and thoroughly rinsed. Indoor and parade flags should be dry-cleaned. Damaged flags can be repaired and used as long as the overall dimensions are not noticeably altered. American Legion Posts and local governments often have facilities to dispose of unserviceable flags.

Store your flag in a clean, well-ventilated area.
