#### **Deed Restrictions**

Warning, and Buyer Beware!

Selling Solar door-to-door is becoming common among Scammers. They may often pose as utility or government officials trying to promote a new or unique solar program in the area. Don't be victimized, do your homework, if you ARE interested in solar panels, always! get three bids, compare, and verify the business with the Better Business Bureau.

NOISE: No extensive or extremely loud and nuisance noises for neighbors. The City of Houston Sound Ordinance states that Sound cannot exceed 65 decibels during the **daytime**, and 58 decibels at **night** in residential areas. Any sound levels above those limits requires a permit. So, let's please be considerate of our neighbors when having parties.

**RENTERS** are Not exempt from Deed Restrictions and are expected to comply the same as homeowners.

**PARKING:** Another friendly reminder, parking on the grass is prohibited, let's keep our neighborhood looking good

### Rules and Regulations of Gulf Meadows

- 1. Do not park vehicles, trailers, or boats in the front and side yards of home, on grass.
- Keep wrecked vehicles stored in enclosed areas at your property.
- 3. Do not store inoperable vehicles on the street.
- 4. Do not leave cars with flat tires on streets and driveways for a long time.
- 5. Keep ALL boats covered (to alleviate standing water and mosquitoes).
- Do not bring or park eighteen-wheel cabs in Gulf Meadows (Hard on streets).
- 7. Mow and edge yards regularly.
- 8. Do not store clutter in the front and side yards of your home.
- Obey heavy trash schedule. Do not put trash out too early.
- 10. Control rodents around your property.
- 11. Install address on property.
- 12. Repair or replace broken fence(s) on your property.
- Keep dogs on leashes when you leave your property.
- 14. Do not install basketball goals on the street(s). It is very dangerous!
- 15. Do not store garbage can(s) in front of home.

#### Citizens' Patrol

I received a call in January from a resident who saw police activity at the corner of Springtime and Gulf Valley. I was not able to find out what happened there. However, if you see something, please let me know so I can put it in the newsletter. As I patrol through the neighborhood, I see the recycle bins sitting out at the curb for a week or sometimes two when there is a holiday. I thought it would be good to list the city's rules for renting Walter Jones Park for get-togethers:

- To use the green space only (picnic area) it is first come, first served.
- (2) There is no Pavilion fee. This is free.
- (3) If you are using outside vendors such as petting zoo or jumping bouncers, you must provide copies of insurance to the city and register online if you are planning to have these.
- (4) The fee for three hours or less is \$31.00, up to \$94.00 for a full day.
- (5) Fill out a form on Houston Parks and Recreation website.
