## Code Enforcement Reports

Please note that Code Enforcement Complaints cannot be submitted through the GoLongBeach app.

Some of these issues might include:

- Dead landscaping
- Deteriorated electrical, exposed wiring and circuit breakers
- Deteriorated plumbing (leaking ceiling)
- Garage accessibility (blocked access by vehicle(s))
- Garage conversions without permits
- Major auto repair on residential property
- Operating an unregistered Short-Term Rental
- Overflowing trash containers or dumpsters
- Outside storage of junk, debris, trash in front, side, or rear yards visible from public view or neighboring properties, discarded furniture, and appliances
- Overheight fence
- Pest/vermin infestation
- People living in garages
- Private trees impeding the public right of way
- Storage of wrecked, inoperable and/or abandoned vehicles on private property
- Trash cans stored in public view
- Unpermitted alterations to a dwelling or structure without permits
- Unpermitted interior alterations to a dwelling or structure
- Unpermitted or illegal signs
- Vehicles parked illegally on private property
