Deed Restrictions

For a better understanding and for clarification purposes.

Parking vehicles on the front lawn violates the City of Houston's "Prohibited Yard Parking Ordinance," which is enforced by the Houston Police Department. Let's keep our streetscapes clean and abide by the rules.

Additionally, if you're planning any home remodeling, room additions, or new building structures, please keep the Gulf Meadows Civic Club informed. This helps ensure that any necessary permits are obtained and maintains the integrity of our residential character.

Remember, adhering to deed restrictions is essential for preserving the beauty of our community and safeguarding property values. Let's work together to keep Gulf Meadows a wonderful place to live!

Rules and Regulations of Gulf Meadows

- 1. Do not park vehicles, trailers, or boats in the front and side yards of home, on grass.
- 2. Keep wrecked vehicles stored in enclosed areas at your property.
- 3. Do not store inoperable vehicles on the street.
- 4. Do not leave cars with flat tires on streets and driveways for a long time.
- Keep ALL boats covered (to alleviate standing water and mosquitoes).
- Do not bring or park eighteen-wheel cabs in Gulf Meadows (Hard on streets).
- 7. Mow and edge yards regularly.
- 8. Do not store clutter in the front and side yards of your home.
- 9. Obey heavy trash schedule. Do not put trash out too early.
- 10. Control rodents around your property.
- 11. Install address on property.
- 12. Repair or replace broken fence(s) on your property.
- 13. Keep dogs on leashes when you leave your property.
- 14. Do not install basketball goals on the street(s). It is very dangerous!
- 15. Do not store garbage can(s) in front of home.

I thought it would be good to list the city's rules for renting Walter Jones Park for get-togethers:

- (1) To use the green space only (picnic area) it is first come, first served.
- (2) There is no Pavilion fee. This is free.
- (3) If you are using outside vendors such as petting zoo or jumping bouncers, you must provide copies of insurance to the city and register online if you are planning to have these.
- (4) The fee for three hours or less is \$31.00, up to \$94.00 for a full day.
- (5) Fill out a form on Houston Parks and Recreation website.
