Neighborhood Updates: Let's Keep Our Community Safe and Welcoming!

We have noticed that some of our corner street signs are missing. These have been reported to COH 311 for replacement. Additionally, please ensure that house numbers are clearly visible from the street. Corner street signs and house numbers are crucial not only for convenience but also for emergency responders to locate those in need quickly.

Homeowners are responsible for the construction, maintenance, and repair of their fences. If a fence is shared between two properties, consider discussing cost-sharing with your neighbor.

Lastly, when inviting guests to your home, please be considerate of our neighbors' privacy and living spaces.

Although Deed Restrictions may limit how you can use your property, it's a helpful tool to enhance real property value and preserve its character.

Rules and Regulations of Gulf Meadows

- 1. Do not park vehicles, trailers, or boats in the front and side yards of home, on grass.
- 2. Keep wrecked vehicles stored in enclosed areas at your property.
- 3. Do not store inoperable vehicles on the street.
- 4. Do not leave cars with flat tires on streets and driveways for a long time.
- Keep ALL boats covered (to alleviate standing water and mosquitoes).
- Do not bring or park eighteen-wheel cabs in Gulf Meadows (Hard on streets).
- 7. Mow and edge yards regularly.
- Do not store clutter in the front and side yards of your home.
- Obey heavy trash schedule. Do not put trash out too early.
- 10. Control rodents around your property.
- 11. Install address on property.
- 12. Repair or replace broken fence(s) on your property.
- 13. Keep dogs on leashes when you leave your property.
- 14. Do not install basketball goals **on** the street(s). It is very dangerous!
- 15. Do not store garbage can(s) in front of home.

I thought it would be good to list the city's rules for renting Walter Jones Park for get-togethers:

- (1) To use the green space only (picnic area) it is first come. first served.
- (2) There is no Pavilion fee. This is free.
- (3) If you are using outside vendors such as petting zoo or jumping bouncers, you must provide copies of insurance to the city and register online if you are planning to have these.
- (4) The fee for three hours or less is \$31.00, up to \$94.00 for a full day. See online reservation.
- (5) Fill out a form on Houston Parks and Recreation website. https://www.houstontx.gov/parks/ search for park: Jones (Walter) Park
