<u>unified voice</u> when dealing with concerns and complaints not handled by the Maintenance Corp (BC Consulting). <u>For example</u>, the Civic Association has petitioned the county to remedy flooding on route 9 during the rainy season and request to widen the right-turn lane at Llangollen Blvd and route 13. These are issues the Maint Corp will not address. As the surrounding communities grow more issues could arise.

So, the majority of voters ruled to keep the Civic Association. To the voters, thank you for your participation. <u>To the non-voters, please find a way to participate in community polls, events, and meetings</u>.
