

To whomever left four cats in a carrier on Thrasher Drive—I am not a kennel! If you have a cat, dog, etc, take it to Animal Services or call the Humane Society to get on their list to relinquish your pet. If you have any questions about a cat or dog's health, I may be able to answer the question, otherwise; call your vet as every pet has to be spayed or neutered and have rabies shots. I took the four cats somewhere and, hopefully, their health was checked and tested for feline aids (as it is rapid here). So be responsible—spay, neuter, license, leash, and keep pet shots up to date. Better to take your unwanted pet to Animal Services than live a life of misery in the streets being abused by people, disease, or getting hit by a vehicle. It's more humane to put them down if you cannot find them a home.

BOAT RAMP KEYS: You can purchase a new key from John Sprovkin (623-1363). Keys are \$25.00 for the year. Please turn in your old key when obtaining a new key.

BOATING AND SKIING RULES: Everyone purchasing boat ramp keys receives a copy of the rules. There is also a sign posted with the rules near the boat ramp. Please read them and observe all the rules for everyone's safety. Personal water

crafts are defined as jet skis only.

RESTROOMS in the Civic Center building are normally kept locked due to vandalism in the past, but if you are using the picnic area for a function, a restroom key will be made available to you from John, 623-1363. Crime Watch Program

In order to start a Crime Watch Program, each street must be canvassed and signatures of interested residents must be obtained. We need at least 50% of those living in East Lake Park (roughly 163 homes) to sign the agreement and attend the first set-up meeting. Advice on Tree Cutting—A resident on Travis tried to have the branches of a large tree cut, and a neighbor tried to prevent the tree cutter from removing "his" branches hanging over his property. The sheriff was called and told the neighbor that it is the responsibility of the person on whose property the tree (trunk) is located to trim it, WHETHER OR NOT the branches hang over another property.
