New Traffic Signs in Canyon North

If you drive a car and live in Canyon North you



have probably noticed that we have some new traffic signs on our streets. We want everyone to be very careful over the next several months as everyone who travels our streets becomes aware of

these new signs. As a resident of CN you had the opportunity to vote on these signs and all of them were overwhelming approved. Let's hope they do what they're intended to do and that's to make our streets safer.

We all have to adjust to the changes so please take caution when approaching any of our new

signs. Others may forget that we now have stop signs where once we didn't or vice versa. Please be sure that any oncoming traffic has taken note of the sign changes



before you pull out in front of anyone. Remember, we also have people using our streets who do not live in Canyon North and

we need to be very cautious as they will not have had any advanced warning of these changes. We do not want any accidents to occur so please

warn any young drivers in your household to be very careful of the new signs and the consequences of becoming too relaxed when driving in an area we all are so comfortable with.

The new changes are as follows:

- → Yield signs on Bayberry at the intersection of Bayberry and Basswood.
- → The addition of a third stop sign on Laurel Rd. at the junction of Laurel Rd. and Basswood.
- → Yield sign on Evergreen Canyon Rd at Basswood.
- → Stops signs that were formerly on Basswood at Fawn Canyon have been moved onto Fawn Canyon.

- → Stop signs have been added on Basswood Canyon at Elk Canyon Rd. making it a four-way stop.
- → Stop signs added on Cricket Canyon Rd. at the Talbot Canyon intersection.
- → Stop signs added on Talbot Canyon at the Fawn Canyon intersection making it a four-way stop.
- → Stop signs added on Bear Canyon Dr. at Basswood Canyon.

Many of us living in Canyon North have pets. For some, they are an important part of the



family and they're treated as such. They receive the best of care, are kept clean and given a safe environment to live. It's difficult to see others who don't feel the same way about their pet. dogs and cats are allowed

to run loose without supervision it sends a clear message that the owner of that animal might not care what happens to it. We'd like to remind all pet owners that Oklahoma City has a leash law and that law applies to those of us with pets and live in Canyon North. This law not only protects the animal but it also protects those who are out for a walk or riding a bike. Most of the homes in Canyon North have fenced yards so it's hard to understand why there would be any dogs running loose but it seems to occur more frequently than needed. If you don't have a fenced area for your pet, please try using a leash staked in the front yard if necessary. It may save the life of your dog and unnecessary expenses if an attack occurs.


