Brush & Bulky Trash Pickup Week of Feb 11, 2008

Day of collection may vary during the week.

Brush & Bulky Materials Should Be:

At least 3 feet away from any utility meters, fences and other obstacles.. No more than 10 cubic yards of material. Place clean brush/scrap metal/car tires into separate piles. Different trucks collect these materials. If your garbage is collected in the alley, place your brush & bulky materials behind your property in the alley.

If you have curbside garbage collection, place brush & bulky materials in front of your property at the curb.

Accepted Materials:

Brush (trunks up to 24" diameter and branches up to 5 feet long)

Cacti (must be boxed — up to 25 lbs. per box)

Lumber (up to 5 feet in length and stacked)

Lawn mowers (without fuel tank & crankcase)

Scrap metal

Furniture, carpet & doors

PVC & metal pipes (up to 5 feet long)

Appliances (please remove freezer/refrigerator doors)

Automobile tires (limit 5)

Railroad ties (limit 5) (up to 5 feet long)

Metal drums (empty and cut in half)

Unaccepted Materials:

Stone/bricks/concrete/aggregates/tile

Flooring/roofing/insulation/sheetrock/wire fencing

Hazardous waste like paint/oil/pesticides/solvents/liquids/empty containers (Please contact Household Hazardous waste 888-6947)

Television and computer monitors/glass/mirrors/fish tanks

Compressed gas/air cylinder(s)/car parts/commercial AC units/ fuel tanks

Material not generated from the property.

* For a nominal fee city will collect the excess over 10 cubic yards of accepted material. Please call Customer Service at 791-3171 to request an estimate. You may take unaccepted household brush & bulky materials to the Los Reales Landfill. For information call 791-5085.

Graffiti:

Prevention

Graffiti cannot always be prevented, but property owners and residents can reduce the incidence of graffiti on building exteriors and walls by having good lighting and uncomfortable vegetation in place.

Work with your neighbors, your neighborhood association or home owners' association to be the eyes and ears for your community.

Enforcement

If you see someone in the act of "tagging," call 911. If the graffiti is already in place, call 792-CITY (792-2489) to report it. Graffiti left in place tends to attract more graffiti.

Removal

The City of Tucson has contracted with GPC, Graffiti Protective Coatings, to remove the graffiti citywide. Call 792-CITY (792-2489).
