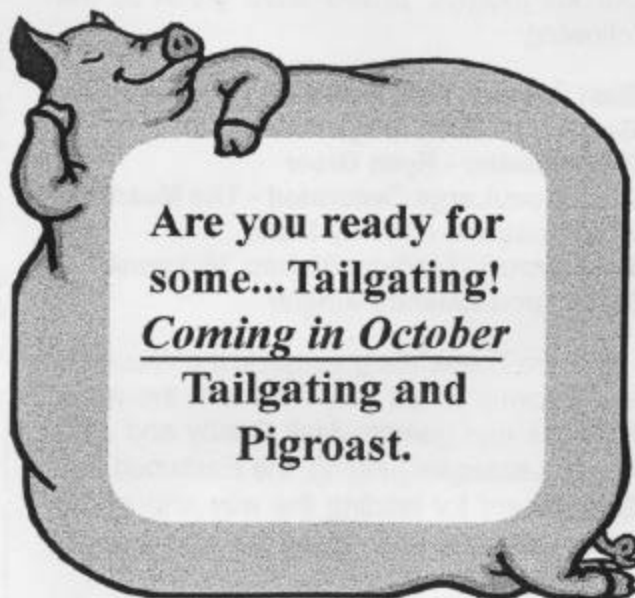

COPPERFIELD POOL RULES

The Board would like to remind all residents that the Pool is for the use by Copperfield Residents and their legitimate guests only. Despite rumors floating around we don't sell outside memberships and the neighboring communities do not have access. As a result of complaints received, the Board has enacted the following measures at the last meeting held on May 31st:

- The lifeguards have been instructed to admit only persons with a validated (2006 sticker) Copperfield Pool Card;
- An adult guard will be present at the gate at random times to help enforce the above mentioned policy.
- Any Copperfield resident caught, passing on a Copperfield Pool Card to a resident of a neighboring community or any other illegal guest, will have the pool privilege suspended for 2 weeks for the first offense and for the entire season for a second offense. This suspension will cover all persons residing at the respective lot number regardless of age.
- All residents should be able to identify themselves through a drivers license when asked by the guard.
- Our policy concerning guests is shown below. In town guests are those that reside within Louisville Metro. Please cooperate with the guards in their enforcement efforts.
- This is YOUR POOL, treat the facility and the rules as if they were your own back yard. Should you have questions or comments call the hotline at 254-2113.

Guests Rules

31. Guest fees are \$2.00 per individual guest or \$5.00 per family, per day.
32. Members must accompany their guest(s) and are responsible for their conduct.
33. The same guest(s) are not permitted to use the pool more than 4 weekend days a year and no more than 8 days total.
34. Out of town guests may accompany residents for the duration of their visit.
35. CHA reserves the right to limit the number of guests.
36. Residents of Copperfield cannot be guests of members.
37. No child under the age of 15 is allowed to bring a guest.

NO GLASS ALLOWED AT THE POOL

Please keep in mind that there is no glass allowed on the pool deck and/or in the pool. This includes, but is not limited to, beverage containers and baby food jars. This rule originates with the Jefferson County Health Department. If broken glass ends up in the pool, it could be shut down for more than a week due to the Health Department requiring that the pool be emptied out.
