Annual Association Meeting

The meeting began with The President (Alfonso

Alcorn) Report which was an apology. He apologized for the entire board, stating that no work had been done this past year and there was only one board meeting during 2005-06 term.

The minutes from last years annual meeting were read.

Meeting proceeded with officers reports.

Road Master (Ralph Garcia) Report. Nothing had been done this past year but he was currently working on getting the trees removed from Oak Lane. The board will also be getting bids to have Oak Lane paved, repair the road from the mail-boxes to the corner of

Vista and repair the drainage and road problems at Eagle Pass.

Treasurer (Lou McGurrin) Report. Everyone who attended the meeting received a copy of The Treasurers report, which in brief went over the budget, what was spent and what was left. Also Lou stated that at this point 10% of property owners still owe currant dues.

Election of officers was held at 1st meeting. (Please see listing on page 1)


For the end of this season and for next summer. We hired C&C Just Lawns to take care of the mowing and weed-waking around the lake.

Once this work is complete we will pave Oak Lane and begin patch work on the potholes.

At our annual meeting a couple of issues were presented to the board.


Part of being a member of an association is that you have a voice. Changes that need to a majority vote to pass.
