To keep these creatures from invading your yard, please keep debris such as leaves and limbs from accumulating around your house and fence line. Keeping the lids tightly on all trash cans can go a long ways, too. Avoid feeding household pets outdoors. Bird food is also a favorite of unwanted rodents. Not only will taking these precautions against rodents help with keeping them out of your yard, but they will also keep you in good standing with City Code Enforcement, and you neighbors, too!
