"Dump-your-Junk" Returns

Here's what you can do to make room for all those cool things you get this holiday season -- Miller's Ridge's "Dump Your Junk" Weekend!

On December 9-10 (the second weekend), you may bring your **BIG** Items to the "Pond" area and drop them off.

This is only for items you cannot leave at the curb for pickup by your regular garbage collector.

Items you CAN NOT DROP OFF

Tires
Batteries
Any thing with Freon inside
Air conditioners
Refrigerators
Freezers
Paint or Oil

Here's how this works - We have established a temporary "staging area" on the property opposite the corner of Miller's Ridge and Dunstable (the park that once had a pond!). Bring your items, large, small, to this area ONLY ON THE WEEKEND OF **Dec. 9**, and 10th. The county will haul everything off on the 11th (Monday).

A few guidelines:

- do NOT drop stuff off before the 9th at 6 AM or after the 10th at 10 PM!
- * this service is for Miller's Ridge residents only!
- Please do NOT haul everyday garbage out there! This event is meant ONLY for those items the garbage folks don't normally take on trash day, things like furniture, TVs, washers and large brush. We DON'T want stray animals flinging rotten food all over the place!
- * Brush does NOT need to be cut small or bundled.
- * Try to maintain two distinct piles at the "drop point" one for brush, and the other one for everything else.

Some items will not be accepted:

- Motor oil Wal-Mart, Pep Boys and most other garages will accept up to 5 gallons at no charge.
- Car batteries Wal-Mart takes them at no charge.
- Tires Wal-Mart takes these, with a charge of \$.50 per tire (less than they have to pay to get rid of them).
- Hazardous materials (paint thinner, cleaning chemicals, etc.) call Texas National Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC), at 490-3096, for assistance.
- Appliances with Freon (refrigerators, freezers, A/C units, etc.), even if the Freon has leaked out call TNRCC for these items also.

Again - do NOT dump junk after the cutoff date of December 10th! This land is someone's private property, and they should not have to clean up your trash because you brought it too late! WITH EVERYONE'S COOPERATION, we should be able to continue this on a semi-regular basis. If it turns into a disaster, we may never get another chance! We still need help with this event, please call if your can give some time.
