## Clinton Shakes Up Economics Establishment; Ties to Atlanta's Jews

A. M. Rosenthal in his Dec. 15 column on special interests, makes a great deal of sense. We do well to recognize that those who serve the public have special interests, and our expectation is that they approach issues with honesty and candor.
