Please note this does not replace the Listbot. As far as I am aware the Listbot will remain for all to have a place to air your views, exchange gossip, tell jokes, or communicate.







benefit to those of you who can establish homestead status related to property taxes, and for it to be effective in 2008; the purchase must be completed by December 31st this year. Based on the constitutional amendment that will be voted on, in January 2008, that exempts the first 75% of \$200,000.00 of property assessment from property taxes, those renters who can qualify for the homestead exemption will have property tax bills that, for standard homes built in the 1960's and 70's, will probably be less than the present tax pass-on. It's something to think about.

Other renters may find it to be a benefit as well. If you are interested in becoming a member, please contact the office. One thing to note, if the new 'super' exemption constitutional amendment passes, new homestead applicants can use it only, and cannot use the "save our home" plan. Existing homesteaders will have the choice of either, but if the 'super' is selected you cannot return to the "save our homes". It is to be noted that only those who are members by year-end can apply for and qualify for homestead in 2008.

On Thursday, October 4th, at 7.00PM, there will be a Town Hall meeting at which **ALL** residents may voice their views on the business activities in the Cove.


On October 10th, the Board will finalize the 2008 budget for mailing and approval by the membership. The mailing will take place very shortly after the meeting date.

WATER METERS:

In the Sept. issue of this publication John Bassett did an article on the installation of water meters.

To date our monthly water and sewer bill is running \$18,164 per month. By year-end at that rate you will have spent \$217,968 for water and sewer. Water has become more expensive than gasoline. Go to the store and buy a 9 oz. bottle for \$2.00.

We have asked everyone to conserve but our monthly bill does not reflect any conservation.

If mandated by the state to install water meters the price of installation will soar. Some serious thought should be given about the water meter installation. Once we have the vendor do a live presentation most residents will be more understanding of the entire process.

Aluminum: The Old Timers Club collects and crushes cans which are then taken to be recycled. The proceeds from the sale of these items help with social activities here in our community. We ask that you bring your aluminum to one of the storage sheds located on Mt. Piney Avenue or Americana Drive. **For the summer, we are accepting cans only!** Please do not put these items in the trash bins – the bins are for household trash only.

Pasta Salad with Orange Dressing



- 6 oz. dried pasta such as penne or bow tie (1- 1/2 cups)
- 1 15-oz can black beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 cup cooked chopped chicken
- 1/2 a large green sweet pepper, seeded and cut into thin bite-sized strips
- 1/2 cup thin wedges of red onion
- 1 orange
- 1 8oz carton light dairy sour cream
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- Milk
- 1-1/2 cups lightly packed arugula leaves, coarsely shredded
- 3 tbsp snipped fresh cilantro



Directions

1. Cook pasta and drain, rinse with cold water; drain again. Transfer to bowl. Add black beans, chicken, sweet pepper, and red onion; set aside
2. Finely shred enough peel of the orange to get 1-1/2 teaspoons. Place shredded peel in bowl; stir in sour cream, salt, and pepper. Juice the orange. Add 3 tablespoons of orange juice to the sour cream mixture
3. Add sour cream mixture to pasta mixture. Toss to coat. Refrigerate 2 to 24 hours. Before serving stir in enough milk (1 to 2 tablespoons) until salad is desired consistency. Stir in arugula and cilantro. Makes 4 servings
