The Board of Directors (BOD) Is governed by the State of Florida Condominium Act, the Declaration of Condominium, Article of Incorporation, By-Laws and Rules and Regulations.

Rules and Regulations Excerpts:

Waste Disposal

Dumpsters are for light household trash only. No doors, mattresses, old furniture, batteries etc.

All garbage must be in securely fastened bags. Any large items? Residents must arrange for bulk pickup.

Only trash inside the dumpster container will be picked up.

Alterations

If the Owner wishes to make any Alterations to the outside of a unit or to interior structural elements the Board mus be consulted.

Alterations must be approved d by the BOD before construction,. Owners must agree to maintain such alterations. City of Maitland permits are require for some changes. Guideline and approval forms for each alteration are available on the website or from management.

Vehicle Parking

Only vehicles as defined in the rules and regulation are permitted in the designated parking areas of the common elements. All vehicles must bear a current registration tag. Vehicles without visible currents tags will be removed within 24 hours after the Resident had been notified

Commercial vehicles belonging to or owned by PLTH residents may not be parked on common elements. (City of Mainland ordinance). Any resident may request that the city remove the commercial vehicle.
