

National Night Out (NNO): America's Night Out Against Crime

NNO is a crime prevention event sponsored nationally by the National Association of Town Watch and Target and locally by the Neighborhood Alliance. In 2007 NNO involved 34 million people in 10,000 communities throughout the US and Canada as well as US Military bases Worldwide (including Miller Neighborhood). NNO is designed to heighten awareness of crime prevention. It also generates support and participation in local anticrime and police partnership programs to strengthen neighborhood spirit and sends a strong message to criminals that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.



Miller Neighborhood will be hosting our 2008 NNO at the Miller Boulevard Gazebo on August 5, 2008. This year the Miller Neighborhood Association (MNA) will provide hotdogs and lemonade to everyone who attends. You bring the dessert.

Michael Fisher's Dessert Nachos

(Placed 2nd at the 2007 Miller NNO Dessert Competition)

Ingredients:

- 3 (6-inch) tortilla
- 1 1/2 Tbsp. sugar, divided
- 2 1/2 cups fresh strawberries, chopped, divided
- 1 Tbsp. fresh orange juice
- 8 ounces vanilla yogurt
- 1/2 cup white chocolate, shredded

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

2. Cut tortillas into triangles, lay them on a baking sheet, and spritz them with cooking spray. Sprinkle <u>1 Tbsp</u>. sugar over the tops and bake for 12 minutes until crisp. Remove from oven and set aside to cool.

3. Combine $1 \frac{1}{2} \frac{cups}{cups}$ strawberries, orange juice, and 1/2 Tbsp. sugar in a blender. Puree until smooth,

4. Set out ingredients buffet style and assemble your individual nachos in this order: chips, strawberry sauce, yogurt, 1 cup strawberries and white chocolate shavings. Makes 4 servings.
