Business Discussed:

- Action Plan Revision discussed, including possible changes in the following areas:
 - Vision: No changes needed
 - Mobility:
 - increased patrols needed in some areas (24th & Freemont; all of 32nd *check w/ neighborhood for input on specifics*);
 - Stop signs possibly every other block with no more than 2 blocks in a row without a stop
 - 25 mph signs needed at all entrances into the neighborhood--when entering from Grande on 32nd, 30th, 28th, 27th, 26th, and 25th; when entering from 4th plain on Watson, Fairmont, Algona, Hazelwood
 - More “Slow, Children at Play” signs
 - Seek input from neighborhood as to on-the-street-parking problem areas
 - Survey of sidewalks and foot traffic needed in order to determine possible sidewalk/curb areas; make survey available at the neighborhood picnic
 - Housing:
 - Work on getting list of landlords, both apartment and rental houses sometime in the future
 - Publicize info on programs to assist home-buyers in the monthly newsletter and ???
 - Land use: No changes needed
- Newsletter discussed—city allows 4 pages/month, so let’s use it!
 - 4th Sunday deadline for submitting info to newsletter (Robb)
 - Amoreena to translate/proofread Spanish version
 - Solicit ads for lawn mowing/babysitting/etc. from area residents to put in newsletter—goal of 5 for upcoming issue
