Be a Good Neighbor

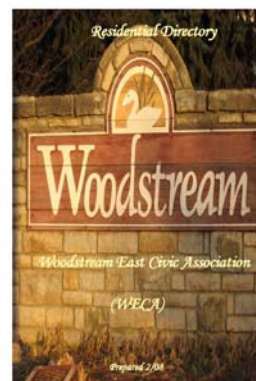
1. Report any suspicious activity in the neighborhood to police.
