- 1) TRIM South side parking lot and remove dense brush.
- 2) Patch Seven Bad Pavement Potholes and flattened-Patch and board provided by TMMC.
- 3) Remove all BBQ's from balconies due to fire safety risks.
- 4) Clean Bay Windows on West side
- 5) Clean and Scrub and Wash Front walk sidewalks including mats.
- 6) Repair garden wall and paint at Intersection
- 7) Paint all "Reserved" parking blocks RED-Approved Safety colors-Paint purchased by Neighbors
- 8) In Process of Painting all "Visitor" parking blocks YELLOW-Approved Safety colors-Paint purchased by Neighbors
- 9) Paint Parking lines using a professional machine-Paint supplied by Neighbors.
- 10) Remove "Weeds" growing out of the pavement.

- 11) Maintenance of Bike Trail/Hiking Trail at west end of parking lot to the Highline Canal.
- 12) Replace Dead 9vdc batteries in Smoke Detectors on Third Floor.
- 13) Replaced 3 Burnt out Bulbs in Front of Building 130 (60 watt 2X) Bulbs purchased by Neighbors.
- 14) Clean wood front entry door and Finish by oiling.
 - 15) Paint Garage #486 to accepted beauty complimenting the Community of Townhomes: Two gallons of paint and 10 tubes of caulk paid for by Neighbors
