

- Board President Hank Levenson, Bobby Cortez and Mr. Halbert have agreed NOT to allow a second entrance to be built into phase 5. We have also requested the "Temporary Entrance" currently open in the back of phase 5 be immediately and permanently CLOSED. Contractors are not using it however crime and trespassing by non-residents has increased near that entrance.
- Several of our neighbors have expressed concern over the use of 4 wheelers, go-carts and golf carts in the neighborhood which are against the law on public streets. **Please complete the survey listed above to log your opinions.**
- One of our neighbors has requested that you remind your children about cutting through neighbors yards too close to houses. On the back loop of Jefferson some children going through to the woods are creating 2 concerns for neighbors: Snake bites and trespassing. Please educate your children on both issues for safety's sake!!
- Lastly while most of our residents are very considerate about keeping their dogs on leashes we would like to remind you it is parish law and they pose a traffic and biting hazard - Please care for our pets safety as well as our neighbors!
