

1. MAIL PREFERENCE SERVICE- Households can significantly reduce their advertising mail by registering with the Direct Marketing Association's (DMA) Mail Preference Service.

#### Your options:

- Call us at 612-348-3777 and we will mail you a postcard to fill in and mail to the DMA.
- Register online directly with the DMA Mail Preference Service for a \$1 fee.
- Download a registration form from the DMA Mail Preference Service to mail in.

2. CREDIT OFFERS - The nation's major consumer credit bureaus - Equifax, Experian, Innovis and Trans Union - have established a toll-free number to get off lists for credit card solicitations. The recording will ask for your social security number, full name, address and telephone number. If you select the two-year option, lis and Saint Paul Home Tour. 
Youth Engagement **Project Movie Night** Schedule at Folwell Park
