The Board would like to remind all of you if you're doing any exterior improvements to your home, you must fill out and submit to the Board an ARCHITECTURAL REQUEST FORM. Any changes or improvements to your home or property that is visible from neighboring property requires that your plans be submitted to the Architectural Committee for their review and approval. While most violations are detected through periodic inspections some come to our attention through written complaints from homeowners.

# Cell phones should include

## emergency numbers

Do you have your emergency or ICE number in your cell phone? If not, you should consider adding it to your contact list.

ICE is the acronym for IN CASE OF EMERGENCY and it could be a lifesaver for you or someone in your family some day.

The city's first responders recommend storing the word ICE in the address book of cell phones with the name and phone number of the person who should be contacted in the event that the cell phone user is injured or unable to communicate. For more than one name and priority, they suggest listing other names under ICE1, ICE2, and ICE3.

While most people carry cell phones studies have shown that more than three quarters of them carry no details of whom they would like contacted if they were injured in an accident or involved in another type of medical emergency.

#### KEEP GREASE OUT OF DRAINS

HOW LONG CAN YOU LIVE WITHOUT WATER IN YOUR HOME? ONE WAY TO FIND OUT IS POUR GREASE DOWN YOUR SINK.

GREASE CAN BLOCK YOUR SEWER LINES, RESULTING IN LOSS OF WATER SERVICE UNTIL LINES ARE CLEARED.

IT ALSO CAN CAUSE OVERFLOWS THAT COULD DAMAGE YOUR PROPERTY AND RESULT IN COSTLY REPAIRS AND PLUMBING BILLS. AND EVEN IF THE GREASE ESCAPES YOUR DRAINS AND MAKES IT WAY TO THE CITY'S SEWER SYSTEM, THE HIGH COST OF CLEANING THE LINES COMES FROM YOUR POCKET BOOK.

RUNNING HOT WATER OR POURING DETERGENT DOWN THE DRAIN OR GARBAGE DISPOSAL DOESN'T HELP EITHER.

INSTEAD OF POURING GREASE DOWN YOUR DRAINS, POUR COOLED GREASE INTO A PLASTIC BAG, SEAL IT AND TOSS THE BAG INTO YOUR TRASH CAN. WIPE THE REMAINING GREASE FROM PANS WITH A PAPER TOWEL AND SCRAPE GREASY FOOD SCRAPS FROM PLATES, POTS, PANS AND UTENSILS INTO THE TRASH
