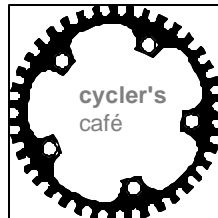

BRESLIN PARK FIX UP

The September 3rd presentation by Councilwoman Tina Ward-Pugh and Metro Parks offered a spray park and an improved playground. The majority of those in attendance lobbied to keep and improve Breslin Pool and lamented the absence of walkable activities for teens in the area. Several parents of smaller children insist that spray parks are not the way to teach their kids water safety. Even with a promise by the public and local restaurateur, Tom O'Shea, to raise the entire operating budget for next year, Metro government still refuses to operate the pool.

Next up – Metro Parks will begin work on the new playground, which should take about six months.
