



May we always remember to pray with thanksgiving and praise to You for this great country. You have blessed us in so many ways that we too often take them for granted. Forgive






### President's Message



### Front Gate

Now that the front gate is in full operation, we ask the cooperation of all residents to make application for the bar code. The Board of Directors recently passed that all bar codes will be free of charge. So no one has an excuse for not having one placed on his or her vehicle.



Only residents are permitted to have bar codes.

Also at this time we ask for residents who need "Guest Passes" to also come to the Business Office and pick them up. Gate Attendants tell me they still have people using outdated passes. Everyone needs a current one.

Also please call the gate when you know someone is coming to visit you and especially if someone is coming to stay or rent your home in your absence. This is most important. We are working harder to make entry through the visitor side even more secure. But we could use your help in attempting to do that.

### Trash

We ask for everyone's cooperation in setting out your trash especially on Friday for our men to pick up. We have to pay an employee to come in on weekends to dump raw garbage into the compactor.

We all question the need to empty trash on the weekend especially when it was just picked up on Friday. On Sunday, September 6th, someone went to the trash compactor after 9:30 a.m. and turned it on apparently to dump their garbage. What they forgot to do was turn it off. Luckily a resident going by heard the motor running and notified the gate guard who came and turned it off.

PLEASE DO NOT TRY AND OPERATE THIS EQUIPMENT, the motor could have burned out costing <u>YOU</u> thousands of dollars. We also have residents filling up the 40-yard roll off with a variety of things - sometimes a complete household of furniture. WHY? Please call the Salvation Army or CASA. There are always people less fortunate than us that could use some of this stuff. To date the trash bill averages out to over \$1,600 a week, \$300 of that being fee for the 40 yard dumpster.

Let us all do a better job of discarding useable items to charity or a non-profit organization and setting out trash for the maintenance men on Tuesday and Friday rather than dumping over the weekend.

If not, the time may not be too far off that I ask the Board to lock up the yard where the dumpsters are and use them only during regular business hours. This decision will rest on the trash problem being solved by you, the residents. Your cooperation would be greatly appreciated by all.
