

Hope you have had a chance to check out the new patio shield roof. Many thanks are due to Jim MacDonald for his persistence in getting the job done.


This summer, in addition to the extensive pool work mentioned above, plans are to complete the painting of the clubhouse exterior and patio, and to install sprinklers in the common areas.


