Miss Otis Regrets (She's Unable to Lunch Today)

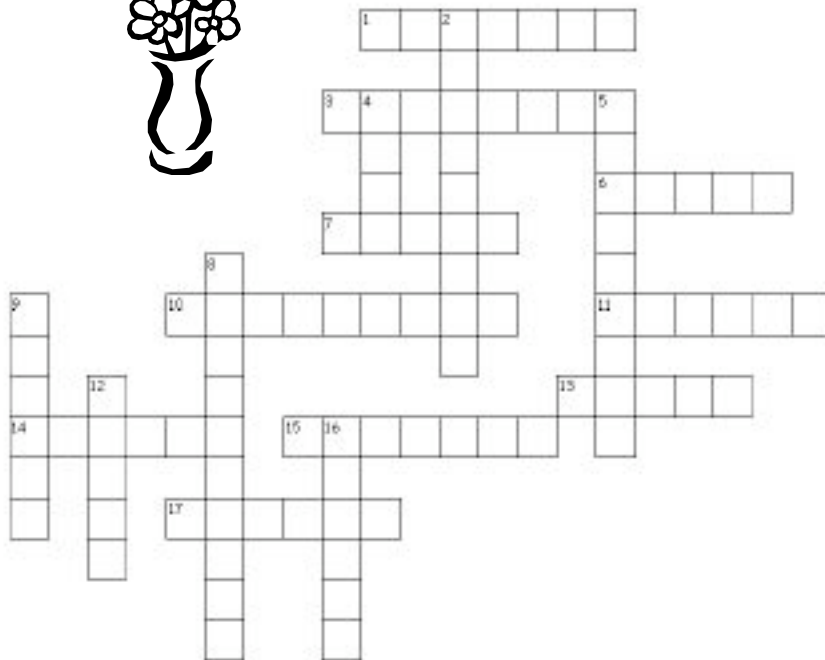
