Crescent Lake Project Event: Celebrating a Healthy Environment

Saturday December 8 10am-2pm Crescent Lake Park

Over the past year, Crescent Lake Neighborhood Association has planned and implemented an environmental project at Crescent Lake. Fueled by over 1000 community volunteer hours and funded by a Tampa Bay Estuary Program grant, the project has had a significant impact on this local natural treasure.

Join your neighbors to meet and acknowledge the participants and get educated regarding the project and opportunities available to enhance the work initiated on the Crescent Lake system and other areas of our local environment. A short program including city officials will present the project, acknowledge the project team and community participants and inform the attendees of the project significance. Small group walking tours of the lakeshore will be offered to point out key aspects of the lake environment; the plants, fish, waterfowl, the water cycle and how the project supports the natural lake environment.

Local organizations and agencies will be set up along the sidewalks to distribute information about their offered services and to interact with the community to educate and encourage good environmental practices. TASCO will have several of their child friendly inflatables and other fun activities available for free.

Hot dogs, vegeburgers, popcorn, water and juice will be available for refreshment. Newspaper and TV coverage is anticipated.

In order to prepare for this event, a lake cleanup will be held on Saturday November 17th beginning at 8:30 am and until 12 pm. Meet near the north end of the lake by the playground. Come dressed for outdoor work and bring a rake. Canoes and kayaks welcome! Water and light snacks will be available.


