# Are You Ready to Survive an Emergency??

Does your family have a working fire extinguisher? A first aid kit? How about working smoke detectors and a plan to escape your home in a fire?

A core group of BTHA members recently learned the importance of planning ahead and taking prompt action in a disaster as part of the City of Dallas' Community Emergency Response Team training program. We learned that the odds are great that you will be faced with an emergency like a fire, flood, hazardous chemical spill, tornado or terrorist attack. In any disaster time is of the essence and knowing what to do--and what not to do--can make the difference between life and death for you, your loved ones and neighbors.

Offered by the city at no charge to citizens, C.E.R.T. is a 16-hour hands-on training program that shows ordinary citizens how to prepare for and respond to potential hazards in an emergency. C.E.R.T. teaches you how to recognize an emergency, how to prepare your home in advance to better survive a catastrophe and how to help your neighbors in the first hours until professional responders arrive.

Several BTHA members completed the class; consider how we can organize ourselves and respond to emergencies in our neighborhood. Interested? ## Samuell Boulevard Update

The contractor completed the concrete pour on Cinnabar. This intersection should be open for vehicular traffic by September 18<sup>th.</sup>

The contractor's goal is to open the new concrete pavement on the south side of Samuell Blvd. from Jim Miller Rd. to Buckner Blvd. for vehicular traffic by the first week of October. This is contingent upon Dallas Water Utilities completing their testing/approval of new lines.

The second stage of phase one concrete pour is being done at the NW corner of Ferguson Rd. which should be open for traffic the week of September 15<sup>th</sup>

It's important to note that all of the above items should be done, weather permitting.


