

Community News and Information

--ALERT! ALERT! To all of our Kingswood neighbors. There has been a recent 'upsurge' in home invasions throughout our community within the last 90 days. Please secure your home and vehicle at all times.

--Last week KCA President Muhammad was invited by Delegate Eric Olson to attend a community meeting at Parkdale High School regarding gang violence and robberies in this area.

Here is an excerpt from the January 29 issue of the Gazette.net: "Gang violence, robberies top community concerns. Residents and community leaders from central and north Prince George's County rated gang violence, robberies and break-ins as top public safety concerns during a Jan. 22 meeting with Prince George's County Acting Police Chief Roberto Hylton. Hylton met with residents during a District 3 community meeting organized by County Councilman Eric Olson (D-Dist. 3) of College Park. District 3 includes College Park, Riverdale Park, New Carrollton and other municipalities. . . . Many residents said they were concerned with burglaries and foreclosed homes turning into hotspots for crime.

"We're experiencing an increase of residential burglaries that's happening a lot during the daytime now," said Hakim Muhammad, president of the Kingswood Civic Association in Lanham, during the meeting. . . . Olson said he particularly wanted community leaders at the meeting so they could voice their concerns directly to Hylton. Among the 50 people in attendance were a number of civic association presidents and elected officials from various municipalities. . . . ""
