Recipe of the month

Hush Puppies

1 cup cornmeal(White Lilly self-rising buttermilk)
¼ cup Bisquick
1 medium-large onion- chopped very fine
1 tablespoon sugar
½ teaspoon salt
1 egg, slightly beaten
Buttermilk, if needed

Mix dry ingredients together, add onion and egg.
(Mixture should resemble thick oatmeal) Add buttermilk if needed.(very small amount at a time.)

If batter is too thick hush puppies will be heavy. If batter is too thin batter will "explode into nothing" when it contacts the hot oil.

Fry in hot oil 350- 375 deg.. Drain on paper towels.
(I use a med size melon scoop as a dipper.)
