Recent Break-Ins

There have been four breaks-ins in our community since the beginning of April. Officer Markus Smith said that these break ins tend to be occurring during daylight hours and the criminals are entering from the back side of home. Three homes had the back doors forced open and one had rear window open.

Locations of offenses are the 3200 block of Russell, Montgall at Russell, and twice at 43rd at Cleveland. Officer Smith said that one group of criminals has been caught already and they're working on the others.
