BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE - Property Code Violations: In efforts to help maintain the upkeep of this community, the Association will take action to remedy property code violations by sending out notices. If corrections are not made based on the first notice, another notice will be given. If the violations are still not corrected within a timely manner, it will then be passed on to the Prince George's County Housing Code Official who can issue fines and will continue to fine until the matter is corrected. Some of the violations of great concerns are: cars or commercial vehicles parked on lawns, trash or debris left on property, or any accumulation of "stuff" in the yard.

NOTICE: To All Persons in Birchwood City/Clearview Manor: IT IS AGAINST THE LAW TO USE OR SHOOT FIREWORKS/FIRECRACKERS IN PRINCE GEORGES COUNTY--THE COUNTY IN WHICH WE LIVE.

All fireworks are illegal in Prince George's County. It is a danger and a nuisance to you and your neighbors. According to law enforcement officials, about 10,000 people in the United States are injured each year by fireworks, and a few are killed. If you use any fireworks, you could go to jail and/or pay a fine. Prince George's County's Fire Safety Law SEC 11 states it is against the law to shoot fireworks in Prince George's County, and the penalties for violation of the law include a FINE UP TO \$1,000 AND/OR SIX MONTHS IN JAIL. Please call the Police on 911 and give the address where fireworks are being used.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH PROGRAM

The Association is still in need of more signatures to implement the Neighborhood Crime Watch Program. In order to establish our Neighborhood Watch Program, PG's Police Department requested that at least 50 percent of the community residents sign a petition to show their support for such a program. As of now, we are not close to half of the needed signatures. If you have not signed, please sign the attached petition and either bring it to Community Day, May 16th or the meeting on Wednesday night May 20th. You may also mail it to BCCA, P.O. Box 7, Oxon Hill, MD 20745, as soon as possible. Please remember the Neighborhood Watch Program does not mean residents' acting as police officers, but it means residents watching over each other and reporting anything unusual or suspicious to the local authorities.
