Remember the Curfew!

School is out and the kids want to hang out . . . Just remember that Kansas City does have a curfew for those under 18 years old.

The law does not allow for "any minor under 18 years of age to (loiter, wander, stroll, or play) in or upon the public streets or any place unsupervised by an adult, without having the lawful authority to be at such a place between the hours of 11:00 p.m.-6:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday and 12:00 a.m.-6:00 a.m. Friday through Saturday."

This means that kids need to be inside by 11:00 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday and by midnight on Friday and Saturday.
